

**HOOD RIVER COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT
RESOLUTION 21-22/06 SPECIAL FUNDS APPROPRIATIONS TRANSFER**

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Hood River County School District is granted the authority to authorize some transfers of appropriation authority by passing a resolution; and

WHEREAS, a transfer of appropriation authority is a decrease of one existing appropriation and a corresponding increase of another existing appropriation, with no net change in the total amount of all appropriations [OAR 150-294.450(3)(1)]; and the resolution or ordinance authorizing a transfer must state the need for the transfer, the purpose of the expenditure, and the amount to be transferred [ORS 294.463(1) and (3), renumbered from 294.450(1) and (3)], and

WHEREAS, the District proposes to make a decrease in the Special Funds Budgeting Account appropriation for Support Services in the amount of \$847,000.00 and a corresponding increase to the Special Funds Instruction in the amount of \$778,500 and an increase to Special Funds Enterprise & Community Services in the amount of \$68,500.00.

WHEREAS, the changes in appropriations are summarized by fund and function as listed below; and
